

Les Vins Alexander Krossa

Alexander discovered his passion for wine in the family vineyard in the 90s. Willing to go further, he created a company dedicated to Languedoc wines.

As a real pioneer and visionary, Alexander Krossa combines technical and commercial know-how to the service of partner winegrowers. His philosophy: professionalize the relationship with foreign clients mastering the technical processes, selection and blending with his partners.

Domaine des Persenades:

Located in the heart of Gascony, Domaine des Persenades has been in the family since 1650 and contains over 90 ha (222 acres) of Ugni Blanc, Colombard, Sauvignon, Gros Manseng, Petit Manseng, Merlot, Chardonnay and Cabernet Franc. The vineyards cover the plateau of Ténarèze which gives their typicity to the wine.

In the beginning of the 20th century Roger Marou, a well-known Armagnac producer, named the estate "Château des Persenades." Persenades was actually the name of a parcel of vines well known for its aromas in the early 19th century.

Persenades is committed to a permanent quality approach, respecting the charter of the independent winegrowers association. They are also certified "Excellence Gers" and "Bienvenue à la Ferme", and have established a Sustainable Development Policy. The Persenades estate proposes a large range of IGP Côtes-de-Gascogne wines made from traditional grapes raised with care and bottled at the estate.

Soil: Coarse sandy clay

Varietals: 45% Colombard, 40% Ugni Blanc, 15% Chardonnay

Tasting notes:

The latest blend that is perfectly balanced, dry yet fruity. It has pleasant notes of citrus and exotic fruits.

Food pairings: As an aperitif or with fish, poultry and white meats.

Service temperature: 8-10°C
